### Main Street Update

The main sewer line near the service connection going into Weberg accounting collapsed, which caused the hole in Main Street a few weekends ago. As we had to dig to fix the problem, we will also replace the sewer pipe to the main. Due to where it is, we had to remove excess water first (de-water), which is a slow process as the water table is so high there and the pipe is very deep. Once we are finished de-watering, we will start digging. We are going to replace all service connections to the property lines while we have it open and possibly the main water line if needed. Repairs could take a couple of weeks.

We were also dealing with what we thought to be a water break somewhere in town. It was determined that water was running under the elementary school, which was due to an old valve draining into the weeping tile. It was once operational prior to additions being added to the building. The valve has been closed and will be sealed so it can't be used anymore.

The water line going into the rink will also be repaired over the next couple of weeks. The line had sprung a leak at the end of the season.

Updates will continue to be posted on the phone tree and on the website.
